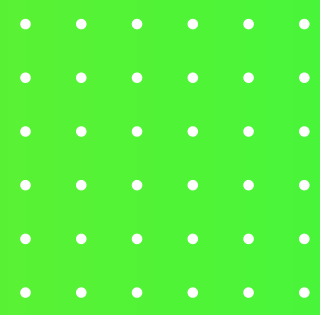

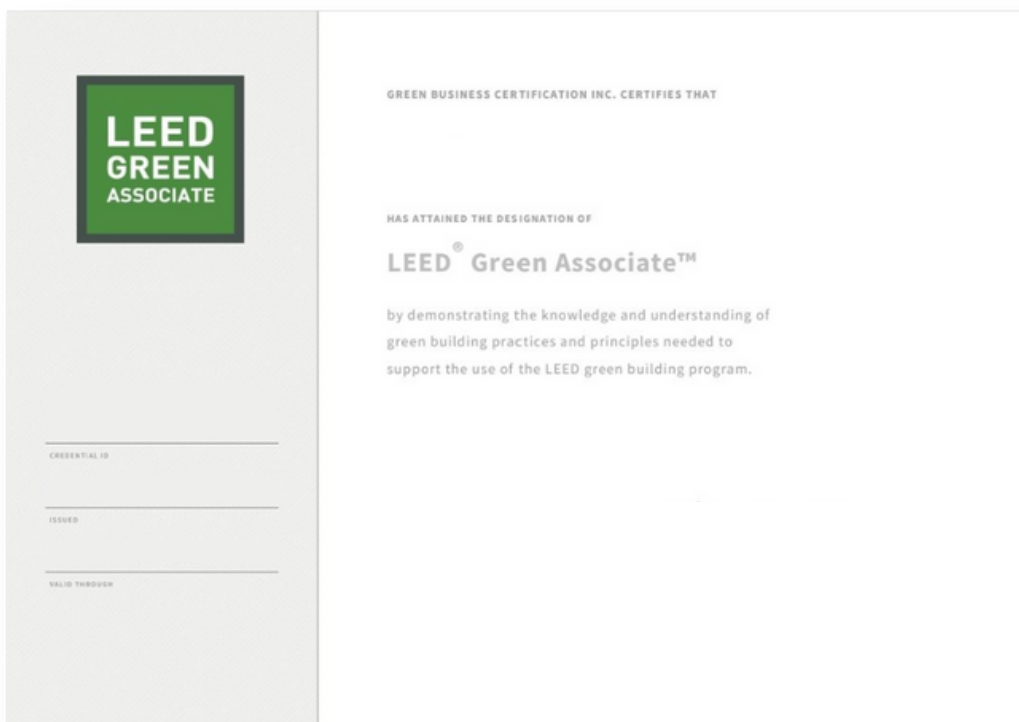

→ EXAM RESULTS

Exam is scored between 125 and 200 with a passing score of 170 or higher. Pass or fail is displayed on the screen at the end of the exam and the score is sent after a few minutes by mail.

To view the credential, you have to login to your USGBC account and go to credentials.

→ USING THE TITLE

You can use the title "LEED Green Associate" but not "LEED GA" according to USGBC

MAINTAIN YOUR CREDENTIAL

→ EVERY 2 YEARS

You need to complete 15 hours of continuing education (CE). 3 hours of the 15 need to be LEED-specific

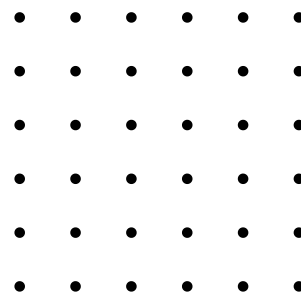
