

\rightarrow EXAM RESULTS

Exam is scored between 125 and 200 with a passing score of 170 or higher. Pass or fail is displayed on the screen at the end of the exam and the score is sent after a few minutes by mail.

To view the credential, you have to login to your USGBC account and go to credentials.

\rightarrow USING THE TITLE

You can use the title "LEED Green Associate" but not "LEED GA" according to USGBC
